**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION NOTICE**

The Waterbury Bar Association offers three scholarships:

- 1) \$1,500.00, Waterbury Bar Association Scholarship
- 2) \$1,000.00, Bar President's Scholarship
- 3) \$1,000.00, Edward Traurig Scholarship

A single application is adequate for all Scholarships. The awarding of the respective Scholarships is determined by the Association's Scholarship Committee.

For the Association and Bar President's Scholarships, applicants must be residents of the Waterbury Judicial District (Middlebury, Naugatuck, Prospect, Southbury, Watertown, Wolcott, Woodbury or Waterbury) and be in or entering their final year of study in the Fall of 2008 at an accredited law school.

Applicants for the Traurig Scholarship must also be residents of the Waterbury Judicial District but can be entering their second or final year of study in the Fall of 2008 as a full or part-time student at an accredited institution.

A certified transcript from your Registrar must be received by the Committee for an application to be considered.
