In 2009 we mark the bicentennial of the birth of Abraham Lincoln, regarded by many as our nation’s greatest and most eloquent president. Lincoln, who devoted much of his adult life to the practice of law, was the quintessential American lawyer-president. His background in the law informed both his actions and his oratory. The following awards will be presented:

Liberty Bell Award: This award will be presented to a local individual who has demonstrated a willingness to serve his/her community. The individual must be someone who is not an attorney or member of the courthouse staff. Other than the foregoing restrictions, any individual who has benefited the Greater Waterbury area in a noteworthy manner would be a fine nominee.

Courthouse Personnel Award: This award will be presented to any member of any Waterbury courthouse who has demonstrated services above-and-beyond his or her duty. Personnel at any of the courthouses are eligible and nominations may be made by members of the judiciary, fellow personnel, and members of the bar.

Waterbury Young Lawyers Award: This award will be presented to a local attorney who has demonstrated a willingness to serve his or her community, and who perpetuates a positive image of our profession. The individual need not be a “young lawyer.”

Please take a few moments and submit your nominations. It is important that we take this opportunity to recognize those individuals who help to enrich our communities.
